Explore our heritage, cultural and other secrets in a weekend in Central Victoria. Visit four historic country houses, including a working family farm, join a guided cultural walk with Jaara elders and sample local wines, produce and restaurants. Enjoy dinner on Saturday hosted by restaurants, wineries and musicians from the Central Goldfields. The annual "Dare to Dance" festival will weave through Heritage Weekend, so you can dance in the streets of Maryborough on Saturday morning. Museums and galleries are open, plus self-guided and guided walks of Maryborough, Dunolly, Talbot and Carisbrook. The tiny town of Bealiba hosts a photography exhibition and traditional afternoon tea, while Clydesdale-drawn wagon rides are part of the action There is simply so much to enjoy.



Cumberland House, Bet Bet

Built in 1865 as an exact replica of James Currie's family home in Whitehaven, Cumbria, England. Explore farm outbuildings and discover the secret garden.

Footer's Mansion, Dunolly

Lovingly restored gothic-style house from the mid 1860s on Broadway – Dunolly's Golden Mile.

Belleville, Dunolly

Georgian-style country house from the 1860s with many original features intact. Garden developed from original plans.

Working family farm around original bluestone farmhouse and outbuildings, beautifully situated on Deep Creek.

Maryborough

Collect walking tour information from the Visitor Information Centre and explore the Goldrush-era parks and civic and retail precincts.

Step back in time in tiny Worsley Cottage and the grand railway station.

The Goldfields Art Gallery is a public gallery gem, housed in Maryborough's first fire station.



Carisbrook

Picnic on Tullaroop Creek, visit the town's original log gaol and wander past public buildings and cottages dating back to the 1850s.

"Walk the Country". This is a unique opportunity to walk the country of the traditional owners, the Jaara people. Pre-eminent Jaara Elder Uncle Brien Nelson will be conducting tours along the Tullaroop on Lochinver Farm over the Heritage weekend. Numbers will be limited.



Dunolly

See many beautiful examples of mid-nineteenth century public, church and private architecture in fine condition and continuing use.

Join a guided tour of the town and its history and visit the fascinating museum.

Try your luck at prospecting in the surrounding bush.



Talbot

There are gems of colonial architecture in this tiny town, from small cottages to substantial houses and churches.

Guided walking tours of the heritage precinct and nearby Amherst Cemetery.

The famous Farmers' Market will be held on Heritage Weekend Sunday.
